

House rules for our four legged guests



Dear guests,

We warmly welcome you and your pet!
Below you will find some important information about holiday home stays with a dog.

Consideration

In order to avoid any misunderstanding, we ask you to consider your neighbours and keep your dog quiet and calm, especially at night.

Hygiene and cleaning

Please ensure that your pet does not sit on beds, furniture, etc. Pets are not desired in bathrooms and bedrooms. Dogs may of course bring dirt into the accommodation after walks or outings, in which case we ask you to clean up the accommodation and furniture. You will be charged for any subsequent cleaning deemed necessary by the landlord after your departure

Supervision

Your dog must be supervised on the property plot. Please keep in mind that other people may be scared of dogs. We therefore ask you to keep your dog on a leash in the residence and in public areas at all times

Liability

As a pet owner, you are liable for all damages and dirtiness caused by your pet in and around the holiday property, including features, equipment and the surroundings
